Maryam Foundation is a registered trust working for the wellbeing of children, women, adults and seniors for their healthy living, educational improvements and socio-economic enhancement.

Main Aim and Objectives of the Trust

- 1) To provide livelihood assistance for seniors
- 2) Educational support for students
- 3) Basic Medical needs for all ages,
- 4) Socio economic development for the underprivileged especially for women and differently abled.

The following activities were carried out during the year 2021 – 2022

1. Livelihood assistance to seniors:

We are helping around fifty senior citizens in Vadakattupatti village, who are neglected by their children and living alone without any support. To keep in mind that they are suffering from basic needs for example food. Maryam Foundation is getting donations from friends and relatives and providing 5 kg of rice and 1kg of doll every month to fulfill their basic need of food. We have been doing this service for more than 5 years in the same village. Once in a year we are provide free clothes to them and on special days we provide free food to them.





2. Educational support for students:

We have given educational assistance to two rural youths to continue their studies. Due to Covid-19 their parents weren't able to pay the tuition fees as they could not get regular jobs. In this situation Maryam Foundation supports these two youths.



3. Free Computer Education to rural youth:

A free computer education was provided to 11 rural youths in collaboration with Dindigul Institute of Technology, Dindigul. All the 11 students completed the MS Office course successfully and in which 4 students completed HTML course additionally. Course certificates were provided to all the students. 4. Evening Tuition Center for School going children

To improve the standard of education of the children who are going to government school, they were given special coaching of English and Math. In addition reading and writing improvement training was given to them. And the important of education and its benefits were imparted to the students. Thirty students benefitted through this program.



5. Awareness training to seniors about Covid-19

Awareness training was given to the senior citizens about Covid-19. As they are living in rural areas they don't understand Covid -19 and its serious ill effects. They can't afford to buy masks. So to protect the senior citizens from Covid-19 we conducted an awareness training program in which the importance of wearing masks and how to sanitize their hands were taught to them.



Future plans of the Trust

1. To establish a center for senior citizens, provide lunch and income generation activities and recreational activities.
2. To conduct a medical camp once in 3 months and provide necessary medical support for their healthy living.
3. Increase the number of educational support to poor students.
4. To conduct a free coaching and training center for Police and Military selection.
5. To establish an evening tuition center, train them in both curricular and extracurricular activities to bring out the inner talents of the students.
6. To provide computer education to 50 rural youths in Vadakattupatti and nearby villages.
7. To establish a Tailoring Training Center for rural women to support their livelihood.
8. Assist the differently abled people for their livelihood and getting aids and appliances.
